We are pleased to present an array of interesting after school classes and activities for Peralta students. Aspiranet is the new Lead Agency responsible for managing the after school program at Peralta. The program is funded by State and Local grants and is provided at no charge to Peralta families. The after school program will operate every day after school until 6:00pm. We hope that students will take advantage of the wonderful offerings and stay throughout the afternoon. Students attending *CDC and Rainbow City* are encouraged to sign up for classes and we expect the program to operate much as it has in previous years between all three after school providers.

Please fill out the form and return to the box in the CDC office on Racine at 61st Street or on-line at pasep0809@gmail.com . We will begin to send out acceptance notices by August 22nd and as sign-up forms are returned to the box in the CDC office. We will hold open a portion of slots in every activity to ensure that families without internet access, or new to Peralta, will have the opportunity to enroll their children in the PASEP program. An OUSD, after school enrollment form will be included with the acceptance letter, with instructions of where and when to return to the after school site coordinator. Please tell us how you would like to be informed of your child's acceptance into the PASEP after school program by providing us with contact information below, (either email, phone or street address).

There will be a mandatory Parent Orientation for students enrolled in the after school program, details of the orientation will be provided the first week of school. At the meeting parents will have an opportunity to meet the after school staff, learn about procedures and upcoming events.

PASEP After School Classes Fall 2008

Mural Painting 3rd-5th grades – Monday and Tuesday 15 spaces available

Instructor: Jamie Morgan This popular class returns and children can leave their marks on Peralta in the most beautiful way! Jamie will create two murals with Peralta students this year. As in the past, students may choose to enroll one or both days.

Tennis 1st – 5th grade, Monday and Wednesday 15 spaces available

Instructor: Coach Pam Stewart @ Bushrod Recreation Center. Students will learn to play tennis at the Bushrod tennis courts, as taught by Ms. Pam Stewart. Coach Pam has an amazing ability to turn kids into tennis players after only a few lessons. Students will be closely supervised to and from Busrod Park.

Dance – 3rd -5th grades, Tues and Thur (Begins October 7th, 2008) 20 spaces avail

Instructor: Ms. Tee of Destiny Arts will be back to teach a variety of dance styles including Hip-Hop, creative movement and other international styles. Note the class begins in October.

Cooking (2 groups) – K-2 and 3rd-5th Thursday 15 spaces for each class

Instructor: Ellen Oppenheimer All age groups can learn to cook nutritious and delicious snacks with Ellen. Children will be cutting and chopping under close supervision and having lots of fun as well. Note there are two classes divided by age group.

Origami – K-2 and 3rd-5th grades Wednesday 20 space for each class

Instructor: Ellen Oppenheimer Explore the fascinating art of paper folding with Ellen. She will teach two classes, divided by age groups, of this wonderful art.

Gardening – 3rd-5th grade Mon & Wed / K-2nd grade Friday

10 spaces available for each class

Instructor: Aspiranet staff. An experienced Aspiranet staff person will work with students to study gardening, earth science, nutrition and the environment. Two classes divided by age group on different days of the week.

Creative Writing – 2nd-5th grades Mon & Wed 15 spaces available

Instructor: Aspiranet staff. Students will have the opportunity to use their vivid imaginations while learning the crafts and techniques of story writing and poetry, and be introduced to an array of culturally relevant literature.
